  - 4.1 Discuss/Approve letters of support for the TCRCD and Watershed Research and Training Center grant applications to the Sierra Nevada Conservancy 2022 wildfire Recovery and Forest Resilience Directed Grant Program-Pat Frost presented the letter of support for the Sierra Nevada Conservancy. The RCD would provide fuel reductions and the Watershed Research and Training Center would provide support to USFS with NEPA and fuel breaks in the Bowerman Ridge Area.
