WHEREAS, the members of the Trinity Center Community Services District Board have changed since 2020, however the Board wishes to continue the agreement, and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Trinity Center Community Services District authorizes Assistant Chief Carol Fall to sign any updates to the agreement for the Trinity Center Community Services District Board of Directors.
