RESOLUTION OF DETERMINATION PURSUANT TO GC §53087.8(b)

RESOLUTION 2024-01

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California adopted SB 929 in September 2018; and

WHEREAS, SB 929 was enacted as Government Code Sections 6270.6 and 53087.8 requiring Special Districts to create websites at their own expense except where hardship exists; and

WHEREAS, §53087.8(b) specifies the applicable requirements for identifying the hardship under which an exemption from the new website mandate at District expense shall be declared; and

WHEREAS, a local non-government, not-for-profit organization provides on its public community website virtually all of the information required by §53087.8(a) at no cost to the District, and therefore, the needs of our community are well met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Trinity Center Community Services District has determined that a hardship exists within the meaning of §53087.8(b) and makes the required declaration herein, finding that:

- 1. The District has no permanent staff, and therefore, insufficient staff resources available to design, create, and/or maintain an independent web site as specified in §53087.8(a), and
- 2. District finances at this time are completely focused on funding a remodel of the existing fire hall, and any diversion of funds could affect District eligibility for funding and a timely completion of the remodel.
