ELECTING WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE FOR UNPAID VOLUNTEERS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE

Trinity Center CSD May 14 of 2024

WHEREAS, the California Labor Code provides, with certain exceptions, that volunteers providing services to government agencies are not covered under California Workers' Compensation insurance; and

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 3363.5 authorizes public agencies, through action by resolution, to provide such volunteers with workers' compensation coverage while they are acting for or on behalf of the agency; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors finds that the services provided by such volunteers benefit the Perfect Little District and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has considered the desirability of providing workers' compensation coverage to those volunteers designated below,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Trinity Center Community Services District:

- 1. That, pursuant to California Labor Code § 3363.5, only those volunteers, including members of the Fire Emergency Assistance Team (FEAT), who have received prior written approval from the Trinity Center Community Services District (TCCSD) to provide services to the TCCSD are deemed employees of the TCCSD for purposes of workers' compensation coverage and only while performing services for or on behalf of the TCCSD, effective as of the date of this Resolution, and
- 2. That, pursuant to California Labor Code § 3363.5, the unpaid members of the Board of Directors of the TCCSD are deemed employees of the TCCSD for purposes of workers' compensation coverage while performing services for or on behalf of the TCCSD, effective as of the date of this Resolution.
